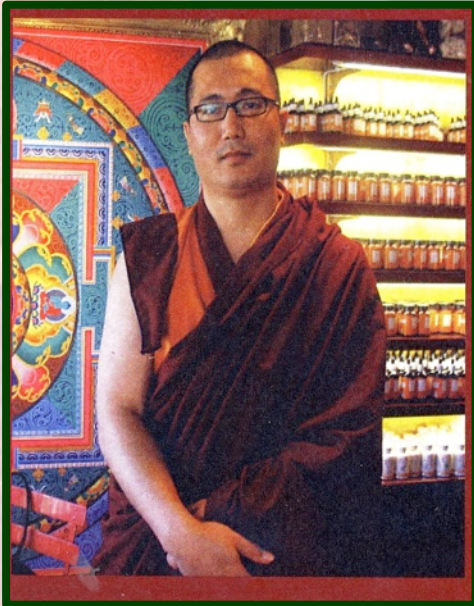


Healthcare in Tibet

Dr. Kunchok Gyaltsen is a Buddhist monk from Kumbum monastery in Tibet. He is Executive Director of the Kumbum Medical Hospital.

In 2001, Dr. Gyaltsen founded the Tibetan Healing Fund (THF), a non-profit organization certified in the State of Washington, USA with offices in Amdo, Tibet. The mission of THF is to provide basic education and primary healthcare to rural Tibetan women and children. The majority (80%) of the Tibetans live in remote, rural areas. In 2009 THF opened the very first birth center in Tibet.

Dr. Gyaltsen is one in a new generation of outstanding Tibetan Medical Doctors and the first Buddhist monk to earn a PhD degree in Public Health. Now Dr. Gyaltsen is returning to Tibet to be of public service to the community.
